

Ride Safe Program

Goal:

 Improve ride safety and enjoyment so that we attract new members and bring back members who left because they felt unsafe

Results:

- Received positive feedback riders felt safer
- When we stopped safety announcements complaints went up

Ride Safe Quiz

- What percentage of drivers said it was sometimes hard to see cyclists while driving?
 - Answer: 93% with more than half often "surprised when a cyclist appeared from nowhere."
 - Research from the AA and Populus
- What percentage of drivers failed to see a cyclists?
 - Answer: 20%, with younger drivers missing onein-three
 - Invisible cyclists: Eye-tracking experiment

Ride Safe Quiz

- Cyclist overestimate their visibility to drivers by a factor of ____?
 - Answer: 7x Cyclists overestimate their visibility to oncoming drivers

- What is the best method to improve visibility
 - Improve your "Conspicuity" Score
