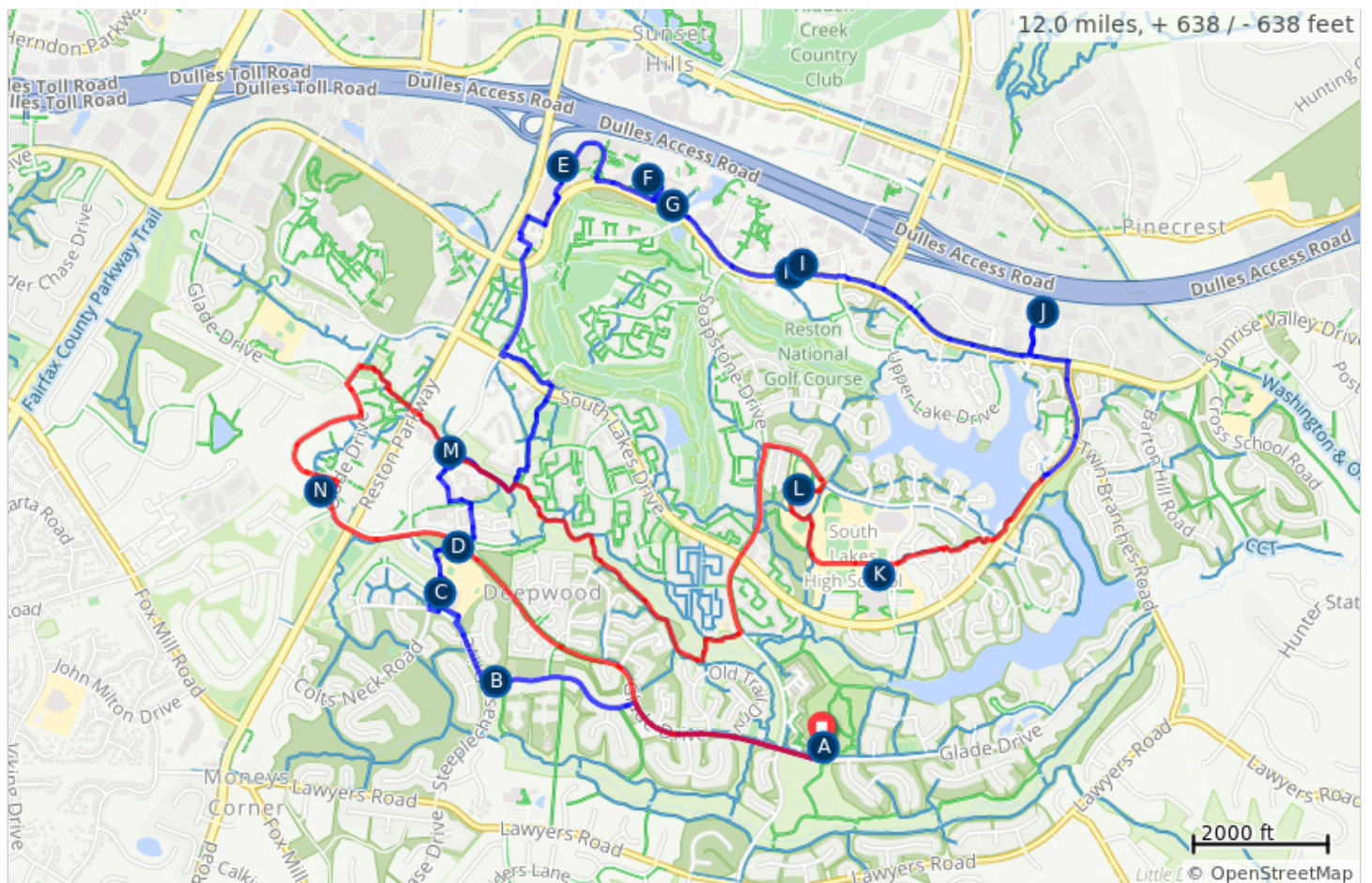


# RBC-170B (12) Themed-Reston Bike Club Public Art Ride - South Reston



Start at Walker Nature Center, 11450 Glade Drive, Reston. This ride allows you to see most of the public art in Reston south of the toll road. Although the ride is designed to be family friendly, there are a couple of short steep climbs as you get out of the stream valleys. Please use good trail etiquette, yielding to pedestrians and keeping your speed down. 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0.0	Start of route
0.0	R onto Glade Drive
0.6	L onto Triple Crown Road
1.0	R into park to see the piece, Horsehoes
1.0	R to exit onto Triple Crown Road
1.1	R onto Steeplechase Drive
1.3	R into school driveway
1.3	Keep L through driveway to see tile murals
1.4	R onto Steeplechase Drive
1.4	R onto Colts Neck Road
1.5	R into school entrance to see many works of art
1.5	Continue toward exit
1.5	R onto the sidewalk that leads to the paved path
1.6	R onto paved path - caution: steep downhill

1.6 miles. +81/-39 feet

1.6	R on path to see the piece, Emerge
1.7	Go through underpass
1.7	L onto path
1.8	Continue straight into Breton Court parking area
1.8	At end of parking, take slight R onto Footpath
1.8	Bear L to go toward the parking lot
1.9	R into driveway in front of stores
2.0	R in front of drugstore
2.0	R toward Footpath
2.1	L onto gray paved Footpath
2.1	At base of hill turn R
2.3	L to cross bridge
2.3	Bear R across bridge, then turn L
2.4	Bear R to continue on path
2.6	Pedestrian tunnel

1.0 miles. +88/-57 feet

2.6	L
2.6	L
2.7	Stay on paved path at S Lakes Ct
2.8	R onto Colts Neck Rd into bike lane
3.1	Cross into parking lot and go towards farthest L corner
3.1	L towards back L corner of parking
3.2	R onto driveway out of parking lot
3.2	R towards Sunrise Valley Dr
3.3	L onto wide sidewalk in front of building
3.4	L onto road that goes under building overpass
3.7	L onto paved path
3.7	L onto paved path
3.9	L on Roland Clarke Pl

1.3 miles. +50/-88 feet

3.9	L on Paysons Way to see Simon, then reverse out
4.0	Exit Roland Clarke Pl
4.0	L onto paved path
4.1	L on path briefly to see artwork
4.1	Continue on paved path
4.4	The mosaic piece, Continuum, will be on the L
4.5	Mosaic Bench is at front entrance to L on Commerce Park Dr.
4.7	Continue across Wiehle using crosswalk and multi-use path
5.2	L up driveway
5.4	Circle through to see Berlin Wall fragment
5.5	L back onto multi-use path
5.6	R to cross Sunrise Valley Dr
5.6	Continue onto South Lakes Dr
6.0	Slight R onto gray paved path

2.1 miles. +98/-161 feet

6.1	Look R to South Lakes High School Spillway project (seasonal)
6.2	R then L through Ridge Heights underpass
6.4	Follow path around on sidewalk to cross driveway
6.5	Cross driveway to continue
6.5	Cross school driveways carefully to continue
6.6	L toward building to view Cadmosaur
6.7	After viewing, reverse and turn L to continue
6.8	Bear R down steep hill
6.9	Tough uphill ahead, shift down
7.0	L behind school
7.0	Keep R through barrier to go up beside school
7.1	Mosaic Birdbath is by Door 7

1.1 miles. +63/-30 feet

7.1	Sharp R into school driveway
7.2	L onto Ridge Heights Rd into bike lane
7.4	L onto Soapstone Dr into bike lane
8.0	R onto paved path just past daycare
8.1	L at T intersection
8.2	R after bridge to stay on Trail
8.2	Continue on main trail, ignoring neighborhood connectors
8.6	Cross Bridge #33 then turn L
8.7	Bear L at the next fork
8.8	Bear R here - do not go L
8.9	Cross Bridge 28 then Bridge 26 then turn R
9.2	Bear R towards Thoreau's Ensemble
9.2	Go through underpass

2.1 miles. +129/-118 feet

9.3	Go through Reston Parkway underpass
9.4	Keep R
9.5	R on path
9.5	L to go in front of community center
9.6	L onto Pinecrest Road into bike lane
9.6	L onto Glade Drive
9.7	R onto Green Range Dr
10.1	R into Dogwood Pool to view Flux
10.1	Make a U-turn to go back to route
10.2	R onto Green Range Dr
10.2	R onto Glade Dr
10.4	Use signal to cross Reston Parkway to continue on Glade
11.9	Cross 4 way stop to finish route at Walker Nature Center
12.0	L into Walker Nature Center

2.8 miles. +113/-143 feet

12.0	End of route
