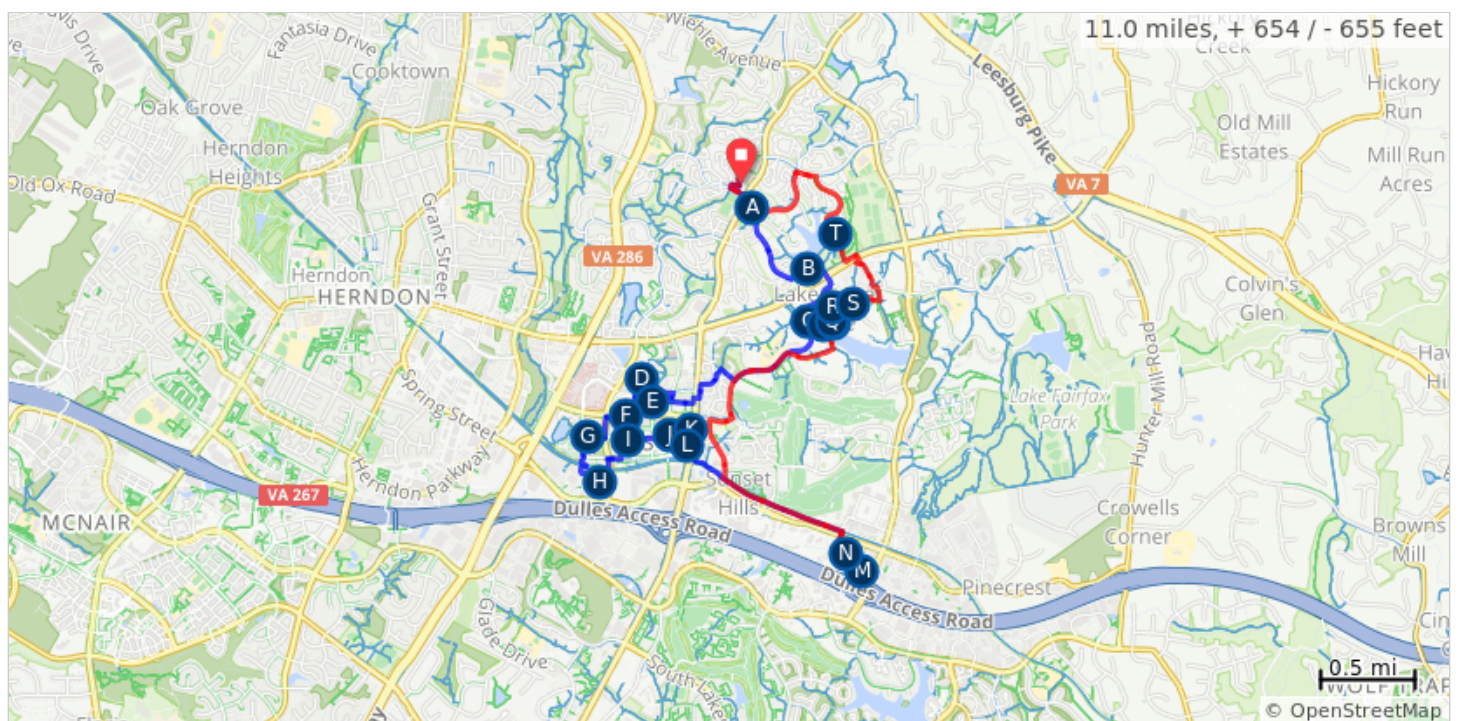


RBC-170C (11) Themed-Reston Bike Club Public Art Ride - North Reston



The ride begins at North Point Village Center, 1452 Reston Parkway, Reston, VA 20190. This ride allows you to see most of the public art north of the toll road in Reston. Although the ride is designed to be family friendly, there are a couple of short steep climbs as you get out of the stream valleys. Please use good trail etiquette, yielding to pedestrians and keeping your speed down. RBC-170C (11) Themed-Reston Bike Club Public Art Ride - North Reston

0.0	Start of route
0.0	Exit North Point Village Center onto Lake Newport heading east to cross Reston Parkway
0.1	L onto Lake Newport Rd
0.3	R into Lake Newport Pool, circle around parking lot to view art
0.3	After viewing Restosauria, turn R to exit
0.5	R onto N Village Rd
1.0	L onto Browns Chapel Rd
1.1	R to stay on Browns Chapel Rd
1.1	Look for Duck, Duck, Goose artistic bike racks
1.2	Continue onto Village Rd
1.3	R onto N Shore Dr into bike lane
2.1	R onto Wainwright Dr
2.2	L onto The Green Trail
2.4	L to stay on The Green Trail

2.4 miles. +168/-140 feet

2.4	Go through the pedestrian tunnel and bear L into parking lot
2.5	R toward shopping center exit
2.6	R onto Fountain Dr
2.7	L onto Bowman Towne Dr
2.8	R onto Cameron Glen Dr
2.8	L into parking lot of Government Center to see artwork
2.9	R onto Cameron Glen Dr
3.0	Cross road to Reston Regional Library to view two pieces of artwork
3.2	L to exit onto Bowman Towne Dr
3.2	L onto Explorer St Bike Lane
3.3	Cross New Dominion Parkway to take paved path to the R
3.4	Look to your L to see mural
3.5	L onto Town Center Parkway

1.1 miles. +24/-90 feet

3.6	R onto Market St.
3.7	L onto Crescent Park Dr
3.7	L to stay on Crescent Park Dr
3.8	R toward Washington and Old Dominion Trail
3.9	R toward Washington and Old Dominion Trail
3.9	R onto Washington and Old Dominion Trail then quick L
3.9	L onto gravel trail
3.9	L into parking lot
4.0	R to go between buildings
4.1	Look L to see mural
4.1	L toward Town Center Pkwy
4.1	L onto paved path
4.3	R to cross parkway onto Bluemont Way
4.3	L onto St Francis St

0.9 miles. +30/-13 feet

4.4	R onto Town Square St
4.4	Many sculptures here - we counted 6 - how about you?
4.5	L onto Explorer St
4.5	R onto Market St
4.7	Look to L for Mercury Fountain
4.8	Look to R for Orb
4.8	Cross diagonally to path and go towards Reston Parkway.
4.8	L at corner with path to go see artwork
4.9	Reverse course to follow path alongside Reston Parkway
4.9	Look to R to see Weathervanes (in median)
4.9	Look to R to see Reston Rondo
5.0	L to cross Reston Parkway at the signal. Get on trail access.

0.7 miles. +54/-25 feet

5.2	Continue onto Washington and Old Dominion Trail
5.3	Slight L to stay on Washington and Old Dominion Trail
5.8	Continue straight to stay on Washington and Old Dominion Trail
5.9	R onto Isaac Newton Square
5.9	Continue onto Metro Center Dr
6.0	L onto Reston Station Blvd
6.2	R onto Reston Metro Plaza. Go up to plaza to view artwork then come back down.
6.2	L onto wide sidewalk in front of station that parallels Reston Station Blvd
6.4	Exit sidewalk and get into lane to turn L onto Reston Station Blvd
6.4	L onto Reston Station Blvd
6.4	Look to R to see Convergence

1.4 miles. +44/-65 feet

6.5	R onto Metro Center Dr
6.6	Cross Sunset Hills to continue onto Isaac Newton Square
6.6	L onto Washington and Old Dominion Trail
7.3	R onto Old Reston Ave
7.6	R onto Temporary Rd
7.7	L onto N Shore Dr
8.2	Get onto sidewalk paralleling North Shore that leads to path
8.3	R onto The Blue Trail
8.3	Go through underpass
8.5	L to stay on The Blue Trail
8.6	Continue onto Waterview Cluster.
8.6	At fire hydrant, jump curb to get on Green Trail going toward lake
8.7	L onto Green Trail before bridge
8.7	Keep R onto Green Trail

2.3 miles. +132/-167 feet

8.8	L and go through underpass to see artwork
8.8	Make a u-turn to go back
8.8	L onto Blue Trail and cross bridge
8.9	At the bricks, begin to walk your bike. Look around for artwork everywhere. Lake Anne is a no-on-the-bike environment. Please respect this.
9.0	Slight R to stay on The Blue Trail/ The Green Trail
9.0	Walk bike up steps to trail
9.1	Slight R to stay on The Blue Trail
9.3	After the covered bridge, turn L to stay on The Blue Trail
9.3	Go through the underpass and bear L
9.5	Go through the underpass and turn L
9.6	L to stay on The Blue Trail

0.8 miles. +98/-44 feet

9.6	R towards Browns Chapel
9.8	Look for September 11 Memorial
9.9	R onto Waterfront Rd
10.2	L onto path parallel to Center Harbor
10.3	L onto N Village Rd
10.7	R onto Lake Newport Road
10.9	R into shopping center. Congratulations!
11.0	End of route

1.5 miles. +119/-65 feet
